

HES 224 – Drugs, Behavior, & Society

Interviews

You will conduct three interviews throughout the semester. You must include the list of question to ask and the typed responses to the questions that were asked.

An option instead of typing the responses in a paper, you may include a quality video of the interview. Permission must be granted by the interviewee. A quality video would include:

- audio that can clearly capture the question and answers;
- video that is steady and focused;
- edited – distractions and off topic comments are edited out.

The week before the interview we will brainstorm a list of questions in your work groups and/or as a class.

First interview = Due **Oct. 1**

- Interview a current tobacco user (cigarette or smokeless tobacco) or e-cigarette/vape user

Second interview = Due on or before **Nov. 12**

- Interview a Law Enforcement Officer

Third interview = Due on or before **Dec. 3**

- Interview a drug addiction counselor, recovering addict, or medical professional (EMT, ER Nurse, Oncologist, M.D., P.A., Respiratory/Cardiac Therapist)

Each interview is worth 40 points.

Grading Rubric

Include at least 5 questions (on topic, not including ice-breakers...)	Typed Paper	Video
8 pts each question	Type the question and type a complete summary of the answer. It doesn't have to be word-for-word, but should fully address the question. Use full sentences. In the paper, include an introduction of the person (name, title, job responsibilities, experience...)	Clearly state the question. Ask the interviewee to restate the question or include the question on the screen. Interviewee's response should be audible and completely answers the question. Use follow-up or clarifying questions if the interviewee doesn't fully respond.
