Process of Addiction


- Exposure to drug or behavior
- Pleasurable experience
- Temporarily displaces un-pleasurable feelings



Process of Addiction

Compulsion

- Frequency of use, time, & effort
- Continued usage despite negative side effects
- Tolerance is developed
- Search for the high



Process of Addiction

- Loss of Control
- Continue use to avoid withdrawal symptoms
- Unable to discontinue use
- Overwhelming negative consequences
- Dependence




